In this course, participants learn how to operate various oxygen delivery devices, as well as respond to and treat respiratory emergencies. The course is applicable to those who may be required to use oxygen as a first aid skill in the workplace.

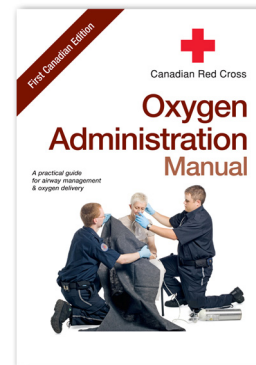
Prerequisite	CPR Level C or Level HCP
Duration	2-4 hours
Instructor	Certified Red Cross First Aid Instructor (Oxygen Administration Instructor upgrade) or Emergency Medical Responder Instructor
Completion	100% attendance, skills demonstration and 75% min. passing grade at written exam
Certification	3-year certification in Oxygen Administration
Recertification	none available

- Breathing devices and suction
- Resuscitation masks
- Bag-valve-masks (BVM) adult, child, and baby
- Delivery devices
- Supplemental oxygen
