The program

It's Not Your Fault (INyf) explores why abuse and neglect occur and where youth can go for help.

Partnership Training:

This comprehensive training consists of one online course (*Prevention in Motion*) plus a one-day workshop.

- *Prevention in Motion* Online training defines different types of abuse and neglect, their indicators and effects on children and youth. Participants gain knowledge about the barriers and benefits to preventing abuse, and learn strategies to build safer relationships within organizations and communities. This interactive online workshop (approximately 4 hours) examines how to handle disclosures, the legal reporting requirements, and risk management strategies.
- *One-day Classroom Session Content*
Participants attend a one-day INyf training which will include; an extensive examination of the teaching modules, review of activities and support materials, and a practice presentation. Each participant will be provided a toolkit that includes: It's Not Your Fault curriculum and support materials, DVD, CD with PowerPoint presentation and pamphlets to be printed for the students.

Successful participants are then certified to deliver *It's Not Your Fault* presentations to youth.

It's Not Your Fault Youth Presentation:

Prevention Educators will deliver an eleven module presentation that explores:

- Emotional, physical, sexual abuse, as well as neglect;
- Sexual exploitation and internet exploitation;
- Discipline versus abuse;
- Impact of abuse;
- Who can provide help;
- How to help a friend;
- How youth can make a difference in the world.
