\$50 Million in emergency financial assistance distributed to meet immediate urgent needs



\$15 Million to support transportation to bring evacuees home

\$25 Million to provide financial assistance after people return home

\$25 Million supporting the provision of cash cards, shelter support services, registration, family reunification, and outreach to meet individuals' and families' unique needs across the country

This means, **\$115 Million** of **\$125 Million** has already been spent or committed to assist the people of Fort McMurray and surrounding areas.
