Because of the war, my family and I decided to leave Syria and come live in Canada. It seemed like the ideal country to raise my two children, aged two and five. We arrived on February 11, 2016.

I started looking for work in my field to support my family. Then I decided to go to the Immigrant Community Support Centre in Montreal to become proficient enough in French to find a job and improve our life.

With each passing day, the Centre became my second family. They helped me integrate in my new community, learn French and look for a job. Thanks to the employability program for Syrian refugees, I was able to find a good job!

Educational programs for Syrian refugee youth covering English, Math and an introduction to the Canadian school system

Summer camps and support groups for youth

English and French conversation classes for Syrian children and youth to assist with language proficiency and preparedness before starting school

For Syrian newcomer families, integrating into life in Canada means adjusting to a new culture, a different climate, and unfamiliar activities.

With your generous donation, the Canadian Red Cross has supported various integration activities across the country, including cultural visits for families, summer camps for youth, and water safety events for children and parents.

In early August, 67 Syrian families from the Moncton area gathered for a memorable day in canoes. Red Cross staff taught children and their parents about water safety and how to wear lifejackets properly – all while introducing them to a favourite Canadian pastime.



HOW YOUR DONATION HAS BEEN SPENT

The Canadian Red Cross would like to thank generous individuals, governments, and corporate and community partners for donating \$3.2 million in support of our Syrian Refugee Arrivals Appeal.

To date, \$2.4 million has been spent, with remaining funds going towards community integration projects.

Here is how your donation has been spent:



19% ARRIVAL ASSISTANCE

- 11,012 Syrian refugees supported by the Red Cross at the Welcome Centre in Montreal
- Resettlement support at temporary lodging sites, including information sessions, translation services, activities for children and youth, and transportation assistance



81% COMMUNITY INTEGRATION

- 52 projects through partnerships with community organizations
- 10,700 + Syrian refugees being supported through integration projects across Canada

The cost of fundraising on this appeal was 5%. This includes fees associated with donation processing and receipting, reporting and communications.
