Do you know the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement?

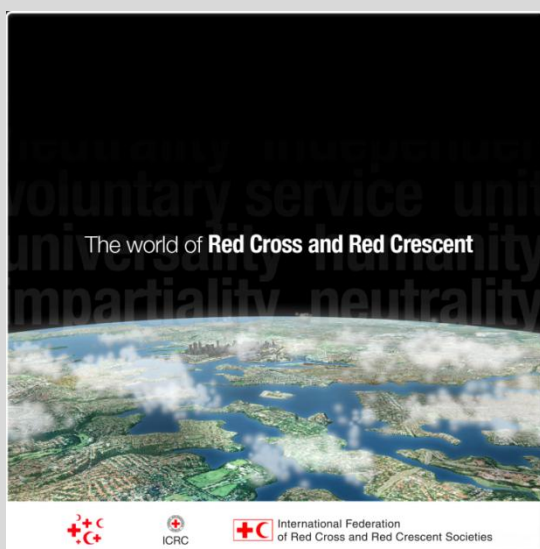
With the Learning platform, all Secretariat staff have access to a selection of IFRC specific online courses such as the World of Red Cross and Red Crescent.

What is WORC?

WORC (The world of Red Cross and Red Crescent) is a self-learning tool introducing the fundamentals of the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement such as:

- Origins and history
- Fundamental Principles,
- Emblems,
- Structure of the Movement,
- Volunteering
- ...

It is composed of 10 modules plus a final certified online test accessible to people who have completed the course.



Who should take the course?

Anyone with an interest in the Movement and its work will find an interesting variety of essential information in the course material. All topics are presented with a high degree of interactivity interspersed with photographic and film material, voice over and animations.
