direct pressure to wound, or

if object is impaled.

appropriately control bleeding

1 Expose, examine, and apply



2 Apply pressure bandage if bleeding continues.



3 If bleeding continues, assess distal circulation, then apply tourniquet 5 to 10 cm (2 to 4 in.) above injury.





- 4 Bandage wound securely.
- 5 Reassess distal circulation; after 10 minutes, slowly remove tourniquet if there has been a significant reduction in bleeding.
- 6 Maintain aseptic technique throughout procedure.
- Document application of tourniquet, including the times it was applied, 7 tightened, and released.
