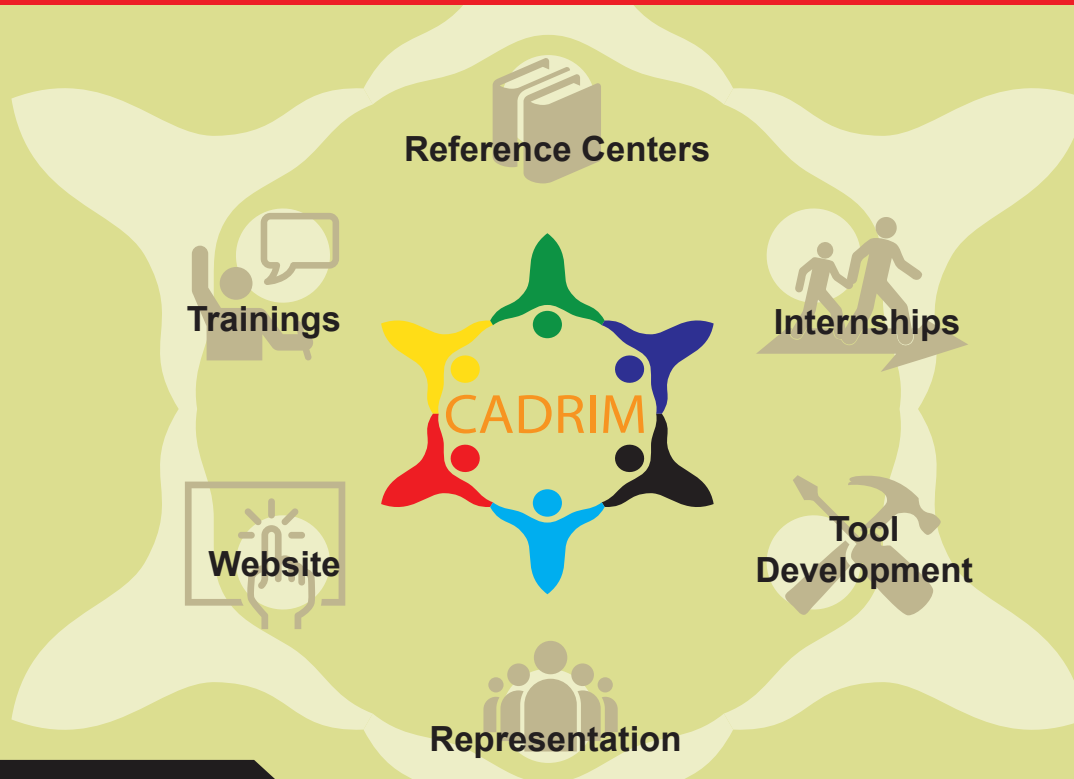
## RED CROSS INNOVATION AND KNOWLEDGE SHARING
